Key customs-related challenges, South-South cooperation opportunities discussed by customs leaders of Asia and the Pacific, and the Americas 4-5 April, 2013: Panama City, Panama

Customs heads and representatives of Asia and the Pacific and the Americas convened a partnership dialogue to exchange views and challenges faced by customs administrations, as well as future South-South cooperation opportunities. Representatives agreed

- To cooperate on four priority themes (trade facilitation, trade security, information exchange, and protection of society) through capacity building, experience sharing, and joint undertakings by customs administrations;
- To deepen dialogue between the two regions;
- To discuss follow-up actions and identify concrete joint undertakings that lead to tangible outcomes.

The event was held in cooperation with ADB, the Inter-American Development Bank, and the World Customs Organization.

SASEC Trade Facilitation Week

25 – 28 March, 2013: Bangkok, Thailand

Senior officials responsible for trade facilitation and customs from the SASEC countries were joined by representatives from the Maldives and Sri Lanka for a 3-day SASEC trade facilitation workshop, and the inception meeting of the SASEC Customs Subgroup. Proceedings and discussion focused on

- Findings and next steps in the ADB-UNESCAP Business Process Analysis study;
- Issues and challenges of trade facilitation in SASEC countries and development of SASEC regional trade facilitation road map;
- Information and experience sharing on customs standards; international best practice on customs administration; a national single electronic window;

SASEC officials attend Time-Release Study Workshop

4 – 8 March, 2013: Tokyo, Japan

39 participants from 23 Asia Pacific region customs administrations attended this Time-Release Study (TRS) Workshop, organized by the World Customs Organization (WCO) and hosted by Japan Customs Cooperation Fund. Eight representatives attended from SASEC member countries. The workshop

- Introduced and discussed TRS concepts and application tools;
- Shared experience in TRS implementation;
- Drafted the process map; and
- Introduced WCO TRS software.

Participants from Bhutan, Sri Lanka and Nepal presented their national customs procedures and process maps.

ADB and Government of Nepal sign SASEC Trade Facilitation Program Agreement

Mr. Madhav Kumar Marasini, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Finance of Nepal, and Mr. Kenichi Yokohama, Country Director, ADB Nepal Resident Mission, signed the \$15 million grant agreement for the program, approved in December 2012. The program aims to increase trade, including intra-regional trade, of SASEC countries through assisting development of more efficient, transparent, secure and service-oriented processing of cross-border trade for Bangladesh, Bhutan, and Nepal. Specific outputs include

Modern and effective customs administration and/or management;

• Streamlined and transparent trade processes and procedures; and Improved services and information for private sector traders and investors.

Trade Facilitation in South Asia: Why, What, How?

26 February, 2013: Asian Development Bank, Manila

At the 115th South Asia Seminar Series held jointly with the ADB's Transport Community of Practice, Anthony Bayley, international trade facilitation expert, presented key issues hindering progress in effective trade facilitation in the SASEC region. Participants were informed about

- Current trade patterns between Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, and Nepal;
- The issues common to SASEC countries in implementing trade facilitation programs, and limited effectiveness of an institutional approach;
- The cost of not improving trade facilitation measures in the SASEC region; and

Potential areas for investment projects and supporting initiatives, including customs modernization, risk management, automation, and capacity building.

'Southern Silk Route Car Rally' revives connectivity: Kolkata to Kunming 22 February – 5 March 2013

After a 60-years hiatus and 7 years of preparation, this 3,000-kilometer rally once again followed the ancient trade routes of the south, organized by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) and supported by the Bangladesh - China - India - Myanmar Forum for Regional Cooperation. CII Director General Chandrajit Banerjee noted the common need for improved connectivity in many of the areas the rally passes through, and the huge potential for increased trade in this largely under-developed region. 80 participants from all four countries participated in the rally, hoping to promote commercial land trade routes that have the potential to bring increased development through connectivity.
